Maybe a private cooking class is in store for you today.



#### DAY 5-THURSDAY **FLORENCE/TUSCANY**

An early train ride in the countryside to Florence will start our day with beauty. Here we can visit Florence's

top museums, the Accademia Gallery, where you can pay homage to Michelangelo's David, and the Uffizi Gallery. Sign up for an optional vintage Fiat tour to Chianti for the afternoon. At the end of the day, we will ride the train back to Milan for the night.



#### DAY 6-FRIDAY VENICE

Today, we will catch an early train to Venice where we will take Gondola rides through the canals of the city, shop and take in the delicious taste of Venice. Visit Doge's Palace, St. Mark's Basilica or book a Grand Canal Tour. At the end of the day, we will take a relaxing train ride back to Milan for the night.

A short 40-minute train ride to Como is how we will begin the day. Once in Como, be sure to visit the Como Cathedral with its beautiful architecture. There are many museums worth visiting as well as taking a ride on the Funicular up the mountain to Brunate.

Here we can find a variety of high-end shops, several beautifully maintained gardens and some amazing restaurants.
