**VIRGINIA & WASHINGTON, D.C.**

**JUNE 21—JULY 2, 2023**

**12 DAYS/11 NIGHTS**

On June 21, National Honor Choir gathers in Norfolk, VA. The first four days will be spent rehearsing, singing concerts, completing leadership training, and taking in some of the local sightseeing, including Virginia Beach. The group will visit Williamsburg, Richmond, and Busch Gardens. Boarding chartered motorcoaches, the concerts will continue as NHC makes its way northward towards Washington, D. C. where the group will sing in a variety of venues. On July 2, the students will depart Reagan Airport in Washington for flights back home.

\*Plus personal transportation to and from NHC week, some meals, and spending money.

Includes all lodging for NHC, all breakfasts, all ground transportation while at NHC, 3 tee shirts, and anthem packets.

It is customary that home churches and other local support systems will match YouthCUE's \$1,000 Scholarship to help their students be able to participate.

A deposit of \$500 is due at time of registration and is non-refundable.

## Recommendation/Registration:

1. A recommendation must be sent from the student's choir director to **Tina McCartney**, [tmccartney@youthcue.org](mailto:tmccartney@youthcue.org). Registration is open until the choir is filled on a first-come, first-served basis, so please do not delay in recommending your student(s).
2. Once the recommendation is received, your student(s) will be contacted for a short phone interview, during which time we will let them know of their acceptance and how to register.
3. Register with \$250 deposit (non-refundable unless the event is canceled).
