All participants are expected to know and abide by the rules of the YouthCUE All-State Choir Camp. A participant who does not fulfill these expectations of conduct may be subject to disciplinary action and possibly be sent home from the clinic.

- Campers must wear their nametags in clear view at all times.
- Clothing must be appropriate. No offensive language printed on clothing; pants must be worn at the waist (no sagging), and shorts/skirts/shirts must provide full coverage.
- Students must remain in the designated areas of campus at the designated times.
- For safety reasons, any outside visitors will need to check in with the Camp Director.
- Lunch, snacks, and water will be provided. No student may leave campus or have meals delivered by friends or family. Students with special dietary concerns may bring their own lunches and snacks if needed.
- No violation of any local, state, or federal law is permitted—including under-age smoking, vaping or possession of alcohol. Possession of illegal drugs, drug paraphernalia, fireworks, chemicals, gasoline, or other explosives, firearms, illegal knives, clubs, or prohibited weapons is reason for immediate removal from the camp without refund.
- Prescription and over-the-counter medication is only allowed if listed on the Medical Form filled out online.
- Absolutely no form of sexual misconduct, harassment, violence, threats of violence, or other acts of communication intended to intimidate, harass, or annoy will be tolerated.
- Participants are guests of Woodland Church and are expected to respect the building and grounds. Participants will keep their area clean and leave the property in its original condition.

I have read the Participant Contract. I understand that failure to adhere to these rules may result in disciplinary action that may lead to dismissal from the clinic without a refund. If there is a violation of campus, local, state, or federal law, the proper authorities will be notified.

To the fullest extent allowed by law, participant releases YouthCUE and covenants to hold YouthCUE harmless from any liability or damages for any and all acts by YouthCUE or its representatives save and except gross negligence or willful misconduct by any person acting on behalf of YouthCUE in accordance with the scope of authority granted to such person by YouthCUE.
